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FOREWORD FROM FOUNDER

Ars86care foundation, as an organization from the civil society, also takes part on achieving the new sustainable development agenda goals from the United Nation, to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure prosperity for all. As a local non government organization, our aim is a better quality education for early childhood by providing new schools' facilities to replace the improper school buildings in Indonesia. One way to ensure the sustainability of our program is focusing on community enrichment as part as ars86care foundation main program, Space to Build.

The year 2017 under the Space to Build, the school program in Gunung Kidul covers the last four schools from ten schools in the area. Total ars86care foundation school program covers twenty one (21) schools scattered in three municipalities including Demak and Grobogan in Central Java, and Gunung Kidul in special region of Yogyakarta. Community enrichment is started from the monitoring and evaluation program which is conducted six months and twelve months after each school's handover. The school program's beneficiaries gain knowledge about how to run their schools daily, and moreover, the knowledge about green features that installed for each school, which includes solar panel system, water absorption holes, rainwater harvesting tank, vertical garden, and the school reduce-reuse-recycle center.

Community enrichment is also planned to be implemented throughout the year 2018, by the establishment of Memorandum of Understanding between ars86care foundation and Eight for Agape, a Singapore based Indonesian community group, to conduct teacher's training covering more than five hundred (500) principals from eleven (11) sub districts in three (3) municipalities Demak, Grobogan in Central Java and Gunung Kidul in Special Region of Yogyakarta, where the school program located.



PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

ars86care foundation started with a group of Indonesian architects who were concerned about the environment and wanted to improve environment quality as legacy for the children. ars86care is a registered foundation for children, the environment, and education, with three main programs, including Space to Build, Words to Share, and Value to Do. The vision of ars86care foundation is to promote and to create high quality, child-friendly spaces in order to achieve a better quality of life for the children, who are the future of Indonesia. Since its existence in 2007, the foundation has worked with more than 1000 volunteers, benefitted 3,000 children in their early childhood. 21 schools had been rebuilt accommodating child-friendly school principal where 6 schools located in Demak, 5 schools in Grobogan, Central Java and 10 schools in Gunung Kidul, Special region of Yogyakarta, were embedded with green features to answer global issue, the climate change. 5 titles of My City Series children picture books on urban ethic have been published while 11,819 books had been distributed throughout Indonesia, and 18 kindergarten libraries had been established in Demak municipality.



SPACE TO BUILD

Space-to-Build program provides space for children to learn and play, to grow and develop their full potentials. This program covers physical development in the form of space for children as one step towards environment quality enhancement. Moreover, the program is derived from the fulfillment of children's right based on the United Nation Child's Right Convention. Space-to-Build aims to early childhood education, where village kindergarten infrastructure provision is becoming our main program until 2020. Acknowledging children as stakeholders, children are encouraged to participate in every stage of the process, including assessment process, design and construction, up to monitoring and evaluation. Currently, geographic area for Space-to-Build is in Central Java (11 schools in Demak and Grobogan municipality) and Special Region of Yogyakarta (10 schools in Gunung Kidul municipality).

WORDS TO SHARE





- To conduct research and publish Child Friendly City Guidelines, to advocate national and local government, to train facilitators and tutors
- To conduct research and publish Green Living Tips and Facts in child-friendly brochures, leaflets, and any kinds of media tools.



The activities ranged from book publishing and distributing children picture books on Urban Ethic, conducting Green Living Practical Tips and Child-friendly City Physical Development Guidelines research, teachers training and workshops. 




